FORESTWOOD ATHLETIC COMPLEX

Teams from all over the region visit this top-notch facility for tournament play, enjoying fully lighted venues for softball, baseball, soccer, tennis & handball.

JANUARY-WABASH LAKE

Once used as a swimming pond for the old Ferguson Country Club, this lovely five-acre lake is now prized for fishing, model boat regattas, & migratory bird watching.

THE SPLASH AT WABASH

This state-of-the-art aquatic complex boasts two zooming water slides, a lap pool, a lazy river, and a children's splash pad play area.

NORTH COUNTY BIKEWAY

Newly opened in 2005, this 13-mile trail runs from the UMSL campus, through Ferguson Citywalk, and on to Veterans Memorial Park in unincorporated St. Louis County.
